STAAR Update

STAAR is an important data point for our students, campuses, and district. If you have not yet already, please review the information on this site. Even on days where your student may not have a STAAR test, a STAAR test in another grade level may impact your student's schedule.

We have also recently included tutorial videos on using the STAAR online platform on the site. Students will practice on the platform before they take their exams in May.

AP Testing

AP Testing will occur in May and early June. The Advanced Placement program provides students an opportunity to earn college credit while still in high school.

Important notes:

- Exam format: YES Prep follows all AP testing regulations and policies. Some AP exams will be given on computers and some will be given on paper.
- Cost: YES Prep is pleased to cover exam fees for all students this year.
- Preparation: We will be creating two opportunities for students to review, called AP Summits. AP Summit dates will be on May 1 and May 8. Students will begin registration for AP Summit on April 16. This event will be virtual and hosted on Microsoft Teams. All students registered for AP have been added to a Microsoft Teams this week.
